- Attracts hummingbirds and butterflies.
- Native to deserts in Southwest United States and further south into Mexico and Argentina.

COMMON PESTS & DISEASE:	Watch for aphids and caterpillars.
TRIMMING:	Recommend one to bulk.
PGRS:	None needed
FINISHING TIMES:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>2 gallon:</i> Plant one 50c per container. Plants will finish in 8–10 weeks.
