FERTILIZER:	13-5-9 Harrell's 8–9 month slow release feed, top dressed. <ul style="list-style-type: none">• 20 grams in 1 gallon• 40 grams in 2 gallon• 60 grams in 3 gallon
TRIMMING:	Recommend two trims in the first season of growth to promote the best plant habit.
PGRS:	None needed
FINISHING TIMES:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>3 gallon</i>: Shift 21c in early spring. Trim plants twice in the first season of growth. Plants should be saleable in 14–16 months.
